### Performance Notes for *Entrance Antiphon*:

The verses for this piece are intended to be sung antiphonally between Cantor and Choir.  
The Cantor's first note begins while the final note of the Antiphon is being sung.  
The first note of the Choir's verse begins while the final note of the Cantor's verse is being sung.  
If necessary, two Cantors may sing the verses antiphonally in the same way,  
with the second Cantor taking the place of the Choir.

Two sets of verse texts are provided as options in this edition. For longer processions,  
both sets may be used, although the final verse of the first set should be omitted, so as not to  
repeat the final Doxology ("Glory be...").

An optional extended interlude for organ and/or brass is also provided.
